Sign up today for the NJCTS Rutgers GSAPP Tourette Syndrome Clinic Social Skills Groups for children and adolescents with TS, and simultaneous group sessions for their siblings and parents. TS social skills groups are designed specifically to work on issues faced by kids with TS while also addressing common family issues. Beyond social skills training, the groups are intended to provide a supportive environment to learn about living with TS and meet people their age who also have TS.

In the parent group, discussion will focus on issues related to raising a child with TS. In the sibling support group, brothers and sisters of children with TS will work on skills to empathize with their affected sibling and cope with having a neurological disorder within the family.
