## **10<sup>th</sup> annual NJCTS Health-Care Professional of the Year nomination process now under way for NJ physicians**

*Doctors, nurses, psychologists, neurologists and other medical professionals in New Jersey who have made a significant difference in the life of a child with Tourette Syndrome are eligible*

SOMERVILLE, N.J. – The NJ Center for Tourette Syndrome & Associated Disorders (NJCTS) is proud to announce that nominations for the 10<sup>th</sup> annual NJCTS Health-Care Professional of the Year Program are being accepted now through **May 1**.

Since 2004, this award has been handed out to health-care professionals practicing in New Jersey who have made a significant difference in the life of a child with Tourette Syndrome – an inherited, misunderstood, misdiagnosed neurological disorder that is characterized by sounds and movements known as tics, and affects 1 in 100 children.

Doctors, nurses, psychologists, neurologists and other health-care professionals working in New Jersey hospitals or private practices are eligible to receive this award.
