AMC adds “The Adventures of Tintin,” New Brunswick theatre to “Sensory Friendly Films” New Jersey docket

On Saturday, Jan. 7, AMC New Brunswick 18 and five other Garden State theatres will show hit movie in safe, accepting environment to those with Tourette Syndrome, other disorders

AMC Theatres and the Autism Society have teamed up to bring families affected by autism and other disorders, such as Tourette Syndrome, a special opportunity to enjoy their favorite films in a safe, accepting environment on a monthly basis with the "Sensory Friendly Films" program.

After successful turnouts in November and December, the program once again will be coming to New Jersey, on Saturday, Jan. 7, when **six** AMC Theatres around the state will show “**The Adventures of Tintin**” at 10 a.m. The tickets will be priced between \$4 and \$6, and can be purchased on the day of the event.

To provide a more accepting and comfortable setting, the movie auditoriums will have their lights brought up and the sound turned down; families can bring in their own gluten-free, casein-free snacks; and no previews or advertisements will be shown before the movie. Attendees also are welcome to get up and dance, walk, shout or sing. In other words, AMC’s “Silence is Golden” policy will not be enforced unless the safety of the audience is questioned.
